Tear off this card, place a stamp on it, and drop it in the mail by **October 24.*** EQCAI will mail it to your county clerk.

Who is eligible?

Any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot. Rather than go to the polls to cast a ballot on Election Day, fill out the attached absentee ballot application and return it to EQCAI.

What if I am not registered to vote?

You can register to vote at any U.S. Post Office, DMV or at yourvotematters.org.

You must register to vote by October 23.

When do I have to return my ballot?

You will receive your ballot in the mail. Your ballot must be received by mail or dropped off at a polling place Election Day, November 7.

What if I don't receive my ballot in the mail?

Go to your usual polling place to vote.
